Garrison Road Residents -Street Closure and Parking Notice for Saturday June 24th



As you may be aware Saturday June 24th is **Ivyland's Big 150th Anniversary celebration**. As part of the preparation for our various events and visitors **there will be some street closures beginning on or about 9:30 AM on Saturday with some closures lasting until about 9:00 PM** when we expect the Warminster Symphony Orchestra concert to be completed and our visitors gone on their way.

On the back is a basic map of the event and street closures which will have typical saw horse barricades with some key intersections being monitored by the Fire Police.

We realize that these closures may cause an inconvenience to some of our residents and we apologize for that. But in order to ensure the safety of visitors and the space for our various event attractions, it is a necessary precaution.

To accommodate residents on Garrison **who must be able to leave during those hours**, we have arranged with the owners of the Finisher Fitness and Creative Environments to **allow Garrison residents to park their cars in that lot**. The lot can be accessed off Pennsylvania Ave. on the left driveway as you head out toward Wilson. General parking areas will be notated with cones. Please park as best as you can in orderly rows allowing room for other cars to get out of their spots. In other words, try to avoid "parking in" other vehicles.

To exit that lot, there is a back exit along the railroad tracks which brings you out to the top of Ivyland Rd. by the Mill and tracks crossing. For those residents that must leave, that will be the available exit and the fire police will allow your vehicle to proceed down Ivyland Rd. You can also use that exit as a way to return to the parking lot if needed. On the way back, let the authorities working the street barricades know that you are a Garrison resident and are returning to that parking lot. Please note that there will be pedestrians and golf cart traffic on Ivyland Rd. up from the Milton Roy parking lot as that will be one of the areas used for public parking for the event. So if you are exiting, please be cautious of that.

If it is more convenient to park your car in the lot starting Friday night, that is fine. Note that some of our musical guests and other vendors may also be using that lot as well on Saturday. We expect the lot is large enough to accommodate both.

Also note that on Saturday June 24th the section of Pennsylvania Ave. from Wilson to Borough Hall will be **no parking**. **So please, no vehicles, trailers or anything else on Pennsylvania Ave. that Saturday.**

An additional option for parking will be the Berger Brothers parking lot. Berger Brothers is located off Jacksonville Rd. with an entrance driveway close to where the shopping center starts. The business owners are allowing Ivyland to use their lot for visitors and remote parking. The parking lot is actually walkable from Garrison Rd. over a small grassy area at the back of the Borough Hall parking lot. So if you do park your car there, it is not a far walk to get back to your residence and vice-versa.

Again we apologize for any inconvenience, but these events are once every 25 years and we hope you understand that. We also hope that you enjoy the activities that we have planned for the day. Road Closure and Parking Recap for Saturday June 24th

For those who anticipate needing to leave Sat. June 24th, relocate your vehicle to a remote parking lot

- Finisher Fitness/Creative Environments Lot
- Berger Bros. lot off Jacksonville
- Anytime from Friday June 23rd evening to Saturday June 24th 9AM

Saturday June 24th

- 9:30AM Street Closures Begin (see map)
- All vehicles off Pennsylvania Avenue
- Vehicles parked in Finisher Fitness lot can exit out by railroad tracks and turn left down Ivyland Road.
- Returning vehicles use Ivyland Rd. and let Fire Police at barrier know you are a Garrison resident and are using the remote lot.
- 9PM roads reopen (Gough and Lincoln may reopen a bit earlier)
